Admissions Criteria

The Assisted Living at Windsor Place program is operated on a social model, rather than a medical model. Accordingly, the following admission criteria has been established.

Each applicant must be:

- Continent of bowel and bladder or able to manage and control the situation.
- Ambulatory (May be ambulatory with assistive device, including wheelchairs.)
- Free of psychiatric illness and able to function with minimal cognitive impairment.
- Able to self-transfer.
- If injections are required, resident must be able to self administer with minimal staff oversight.
- Ability to eat independently.

Building Services

Assisted Living at Windsor Place is home, not an institution. Our philosophy is one of maximizing independence while providing necessary assistance. Our home-like environment supports the principles of choice, dignity, autonomy, individuality and privacy.

Our professional staff's responsibilities include maintaining a clean, bright living environment.

The facilities have a sprinkler system, smoke detectors and a fire alarm system throughout to ensure resident safety. All parts are regularly tested and maintained for proper operation. And, of course we employ a trained maintenance staff to keep everything in the buildings running efficiently. This includes

maintaining the interior and exterior of the buildings and all landscaping.
